## Tramway Celebration Day

The Ballarat Tramway Museum is Australia's most authentic and first solar powered tramway museum.

In recognition of exactly fifty years since the last commuter tram operated in the city built on gold, the museum will be operating several circa 100 year old trams that formerly ran in Ballarat, Melbourne and Geelong.

A highlight of your visit will be the Grand Vintage Transport Cavalcade, featuring several of the museums trams, plus various vintage cars, trucks and buses. The day will also mark the return to service of Geelong Butterbox Tram No. 2, which has not carried passengers since Geelong's tramway network ceased operations in 1956.
